### **Technical assistance to the Administration of the Enterprise Project Management (EPM) platform and support to the project teams during platform operations**

On November 30, 2015, the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco concluded a second cooperation program (Compact II) with the United States Government, represented by the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC), with the objective to improve the quality of human capital and land productivity.

The budget allocated by MCC to Compact II, which came into effect on June 30, 2017, amounts to 450 million dollars, to which is added a contribution of the Moroccan Government of a value equivalent to at least 15% of the American contribution. The global budget will finance, over a period of five years, two projects, namely "Education and Training for Employability" and "Land Productivity", the implementation of which has been entrusted to the Millennium Challenge Account - Morocco (Agence MCA-Morocco).

By way of this specific procurement notice, Agence MCA-Morocco requests proposals to procure the services of a Consultant Firm **for Technical assistance to the Administration of the Enterprise Project Management (EPM) platform and support to the project teams during platform operations**. The selected Consultant will be awarded a contract with an overall duration of thirty-six (36) months with a period of performance of thirty-two (32) months: a base period of twelve (12) months and two optional periods of ten (10) months each.

A firm will be selected in accordance with the Procurement Method for Consultants' Qualifications Selection (CQS).
